October 2010-April 2011: Discoveries Crèche and Montessori school, Firhouse Duties: Worked mainly in the toddler room. Helped the childcare workers with the general care of the children. Prepared snacks for the children and kept the room clean. Did various activities with the children including play dough, table top activities and storytelling.

Duties: During my work experience in cocoon I also worked as Temp staff. I worked in all the different rooms including the wobbler room, baby room and the junior pre-school room. My duties included feeding the children, organising activities for them, changing nappies, cleaning the room, putting the babies and wobblers to sleep, and carrying out interesting and age and stage appropriate activities with the children.

May 2012-July 2012: Cocoon childcare (crèche and Montessori school)

I worked as a full time childcare worker in the junior pre-school room. My duties in this room where the same as above, except I was in the room on my own a lot. I also taught the children using the Montessori Method as this was the curriculum in this room.

September 2012-June 2014: Pre-School Teacher, Grange Crèche

Duties: My duties included the day to day running of the room. I planned a monthly curriculum for the class including individual lesson plans for each child. I based these lesson plans on the daily observations I did in class. I used a well being and Involvement chart to observe the children's development. Monthly reports where done on each child's overall development. These reports where given to the parents as part of the Aistear and Siolta themes used in the room. Alongside the Aistear Curriculum the children were also taught using the Montessori Method. During this time I also organised summer camp activities, eg. Drama, Art projects, culture weeks, after-school trips and baking.

June 2014-Present: Montessori/After-school teacher, Cranford creche and Montessori Duties: As the room leader in the Montessori ECCE room I plan an immergent curriculum based on the children's interests. I observe the children's interests through daily observations, and

short-term plans. I communicate with parents daily and share their children's learning with them. This includes learning stories, photographs and direct quotes from the children. I document all of this learning through the Aistear and Siolta framework. I also organise interesting and age appropriate art activities and outdoor play. Thorough daily cleaning is also part of my teacher duties. I ensure that I am up to date with current regulations and policies and I carry out any paperwork that needs to be done within the classroom.
